

Interior Designers Say This Is The Wallpaper Trend You'll See Everywhere In 2021

The year 2020 saw a lot of change in terms of design. "I especially love when you find a textured paper (grasscloth, for instance) set into a geo pattern," he says. "It adds so much depth."
